Illegal arrest and detention of V1 and V2, torture to the detriment of V1 and cruel treatment to the detriment of V2.

The National Human Rights Commission informs that from the collection of evidence that compile the complaint file CNDH/2/2009/4988/Q the national institution was able to observe that civil servants of the 18th Infantry Battalion of the National Secretary of Defense as well as Tabasco state attorney's office civil servants violated the human rights to integrity, personal safety, non-violation of the home, legality and legal security to the detriment of V1 and V2, due to constant acts of arbitrary arrest, violation of the home, illegal detaining, illegitimate use of public force, cruel treatment and torture, which led to the Recommendation 14/2011
