CASE: V1, victim of crime in state of Quintana Roo

AUTHORITY RESPONSIBLE: Constitutional Governor of the state of Quintana Roo

The CNDH informs that from the collection of evidence that make up the complaint file CNDH/1/2011/840/Q, in terms of what article 41 of the Mexican Human Rights Commission Law sets out, the national institution were able to deduce that violations to the rights to honor and legal security, in particular to the procurement of justice, as well as due assistance to and protection of victims of crime to the detriment of V1, attributable to AR1 and AR2, respectively, which led to the issuing of Recommendation 15/2011.
