Recommendation 22/2011

April 29th, 2011

CASE: Murder of V5 and attacks on the personal integrity of V1, V2, V3 and V4.

RESPONSIBLE AUTHORITY: Secretary of National Defense

The CNDH informs that from the collection of evidence that compile complaint file CNDH/2/2010/1552/Q, in agreement with the information set out in article 41 of the National Human Rights Commission Law, it can be concluded that in this case members of the Secretariat of National Defense infringed the right to life to the detriment of V5, of Salvadorian nationality and endangered the right to life of V1, V2, V3 and V4. This was through the unjust exercise of authority that they had been assigned, derived from an illegitimate use of force and firearms. Additionally, they violated these persons' rights to legality and legal security granted by articles 1, second paragraph, 16, first paragraph and 21, first paragraph of the Political Constitution of the Mexican United States, which led to the issuing of Recommendation 22/2011.
